4. The Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness, even as to what we should pray.
5. God works all things together for good for those who love Him.
6. If God is for us, who can be against us?

### **Tough questions that people derive from Romans 9:**

- Why does God save some people but not all people?
- Has God decided before time as to who He saves and who He rejects?
- Do we have no real choice in the matter about our salvation?
