

## **Hebrew 6 – Week 4 -Outline**

- Doctrine of Baptisms (Hebrews 6:1-3)
  - Multiple baptisms exist
  - Threefold principle in Scripture
    - Godhead: Father, Son, Holy Spirit
    - Man: Spirit, Soul, Body
    - Salvation: Justification, Sanctification, Glorification
    - Baptism: Blood, Spirit, Water
  - Three types of baptism:
    1. Baptism in the Blood of Jesus (for our Spirit)
      - Justification
      - Cleansing from sin
      - Initiation into God's family
    2. Baptism in the Holy Spirit (for our Soul)
      - Empowerment
      - Distinct from indwelling of the Spirit
      - Includes baptism of suffering (fire)
    3. Baptism in Water (for our Physical Body)
      - Outward sign of faith
      - Symbol of burial and resurrection with Christ
      - Hope for glorified bodies
