From the Pastor's Pen

Pastor's Pen,

Let me begin by prompting the question, "Have you ever thought about the effects of grace?" What effects does grace really have? What shapes God's dealings with people such as you and me? The role reversal is truly the work of grace, as Paul would detail in Romans 9:10-13,

"And not only this, but there was Rebekah also, when she had conceived *twins* by one man, our father Isaac; 11 for though *the twins* were not yet born and had not done anything good or bad, so that God's purpose according to *His* choice would stand, not because of works but because of Him who calls, 12 it was said to her, "The older will serve the younger." 13 Just as it is written, "Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated.

As demonstrated in the verses just mentioned, along with many other references throughout scripture, a simple statement can be made: **"Grace turns the natural order of things on their head."** Beginning with the narratives from the book of Genesis all the way to the Revelation, the fingerprints of God are explicitly seen as each page of our Bible turns. All of these upheavals and role reversals are the handiwork of a gracious God who pours out his favor to bring maximum glory to himself.

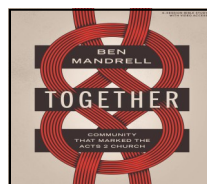
