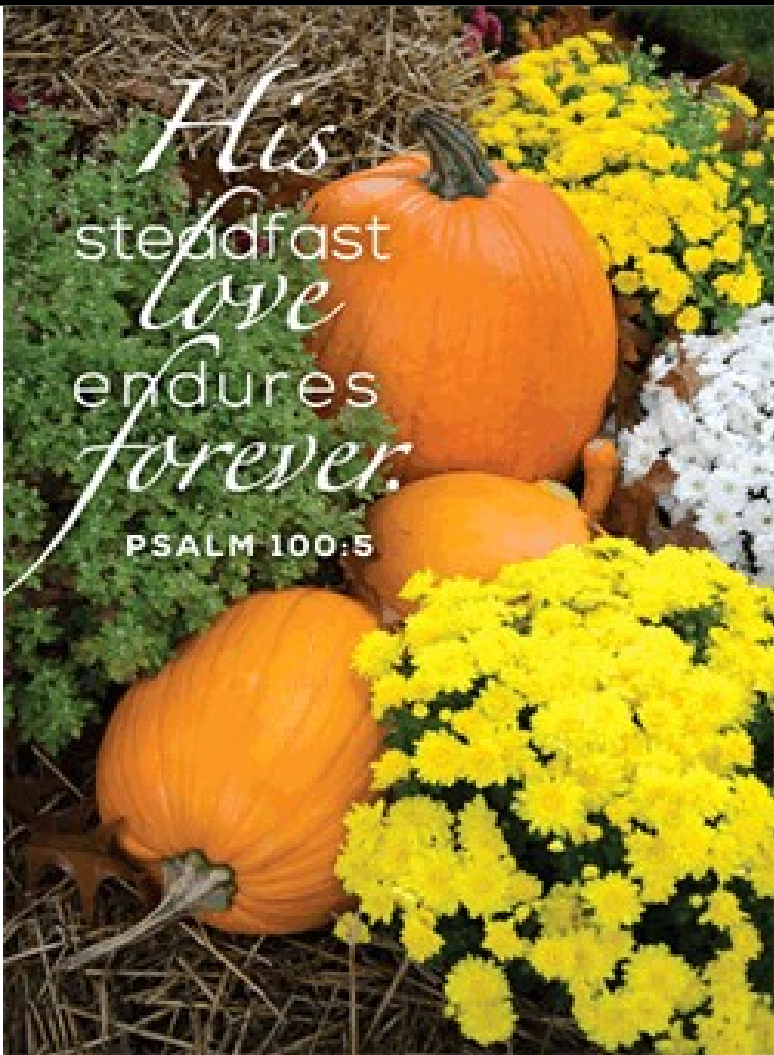

Pastor's Pen,

Good morning, Hillwood family. Let me begin by extending the deepest gratitude to Dr. Robert Mullins for filling in for me this morning. Robert is the Executive Director for the Madison Baptist Association. So, please make him and his wife, Pam, feel right at home this morning. It was during the first part of the week I was reading, and a thought entered my mind, and I would like to share that with you. Here is the statement that brought me to the moment of just sitting still and letting that statement marinate in my mind and heart. "There is no one like our God. He is holy and perfect in motive, action, and essence of a clean, pure light of love and glory. He is unique from the lifeless gods of the nations." But what does that mean, or look like in real life?
