### Pastor's Pen.

To many, this may sound shocking, but to others it would come as no surprise. I was reading a book by A.W. Tozer entitled "The Fire of God's Presence: Drawing Near to a Holy God." In the book, Dr. Tozer describes the manifestation of God to His people. In the Old Testament, we have a picture of this presence of God called the tabernacle. So, over the next few weeks in the "Pastor's Pen" we will discuss each part in summary. The first of those is the "Lower Court" which was not inside the structure; rather it was outside and often referred to as the court of the Gentiles. Tozer says, "I liken this Lower Court to people interested in religion but far from God, who, nevertheless, may be practicing religion." These are those who practice rituals of various kinds, counting their beads, unconsciously moving their lips on the bus or airplane. These maybe one's who show up in church when somebody is getting married or a funeral. These people pay token respect to religion but give no regard to God's way or God's cross or God's redemption. So, the question arises, "How many are just sitting in the Lower Court?"
