

Pastor's Pen,

Whew! What a week it has been. I had the opportunity to represent our church at the Alabama State Baptist Convention at Whitesburg Baptist Church. Nothing like gathering with other brothers and sisters in Christ from across this state, and as we gathered to conduct business, worship King Jesus, and hear from God's Word, it was just absolutely encouraging. As I wrote in last week's Pastor's Pen about the presence of God in the tabernacle, we first examined the Lower Court. This morning, we will arrive at the next place, which is the inner court. The Inner Court had a laver and a great brazen altar (which was not pretty at all). To offer a description, Tozer says, "It was like a topless furnace with a grate underneath where you put fire and then on top put a beast and stirred the pot. It would be here the beast would burn up in ugly smoke." This would be the altar where lambs, the beasts, the red heifer, and other creatures were brought to sacrifice. Now, I know some are asking, "Could you scale it back, pastor? This is a little too gory for me." However, we should not sugarcoat how the sacrifices were made, because when we diminish sacrifices, we also diminish the cross. As ugly and unpleasant as it must have been to see the sacrifices take place, imagine even more unpleasant it was to see a man dying on a cross on the side of the hills in Jerusalem. Sadly, church poets have made our Lord's death sound so beautiful that we even send cards about it on Easter. But that is so far from the harsh reality of what happened on that day, a man stripped naked, hanging in the hot sun, bleeding from his hands, feet, side, and forehead. All of this while suffering and groaning in pain, as he had to fight for each breath he took. Some may ask, "Is there anything worse than this?" Yes! Hell itself!
