



c.) God's Word will endure forever

God has miraculously preserved his Word over time

a.) In his wisdom God has not preserved any of the original writings of the Apostles, but he has preserved countless copies.



b.) We can see God's guiding hand at work in the uniformity of these copies and the sheer number of them (nearly 400x more than any book ancient book!)

Remarkably these copies are 99.5% the same.



- c.) The majority of differences being:
- The translation of people or place names
- Changing the order of words (i.e. "our Lord Jesus Christ" vs. "Jesus Christ our Lord" vs. "Christ Jesus our Lord")
- NONE of the .5% differences have to do with ANY doctrinal passages of the Bible!

d.) So don't get alarmed when you hear reports of the Bible being "changed" or "full of inaccuracies" in the course of copying. God's promise and all the evidence we have proves the contrary!

- So they don't have to feel guilty for their sins

- •To make it more inclusive (i.e. all are saved)

 You are putting something else (be it science or reason or emotion) above God's true Word The Holy Spirit....






...guided men to write the scriptures.
