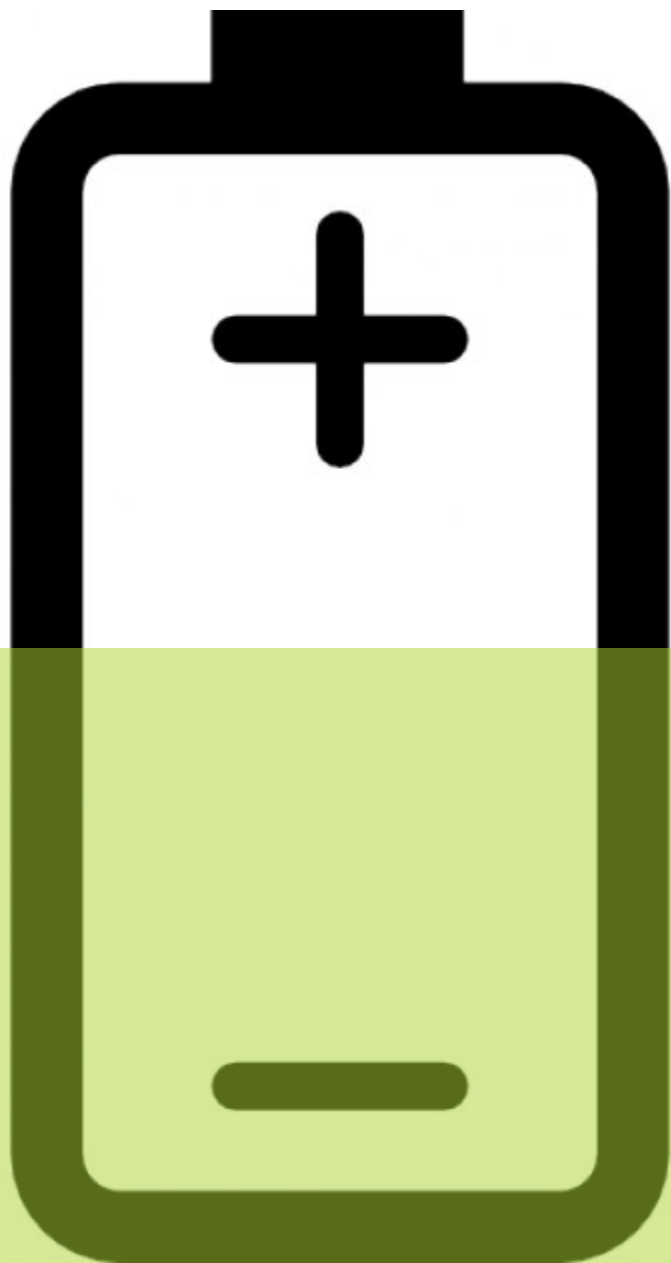




a.) Because Jesus has completely fulfilled the Old Testament law we are no longer required to worship on Saturday.

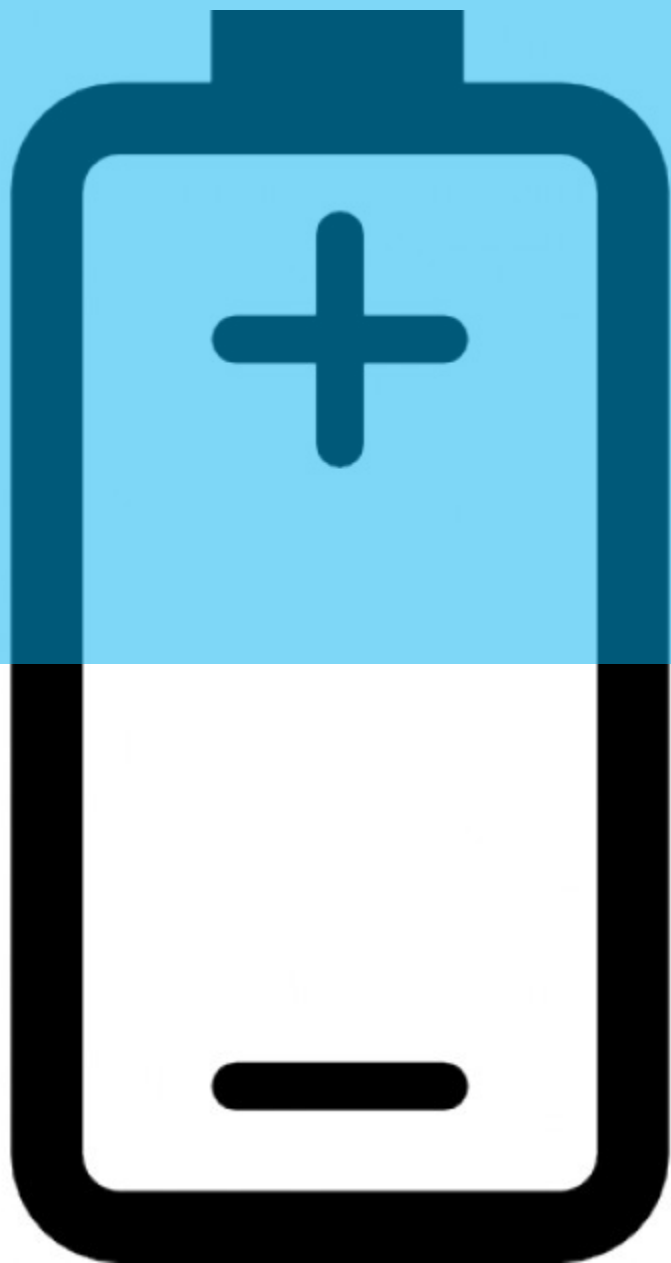

Pentecost = birthday of Christian Church

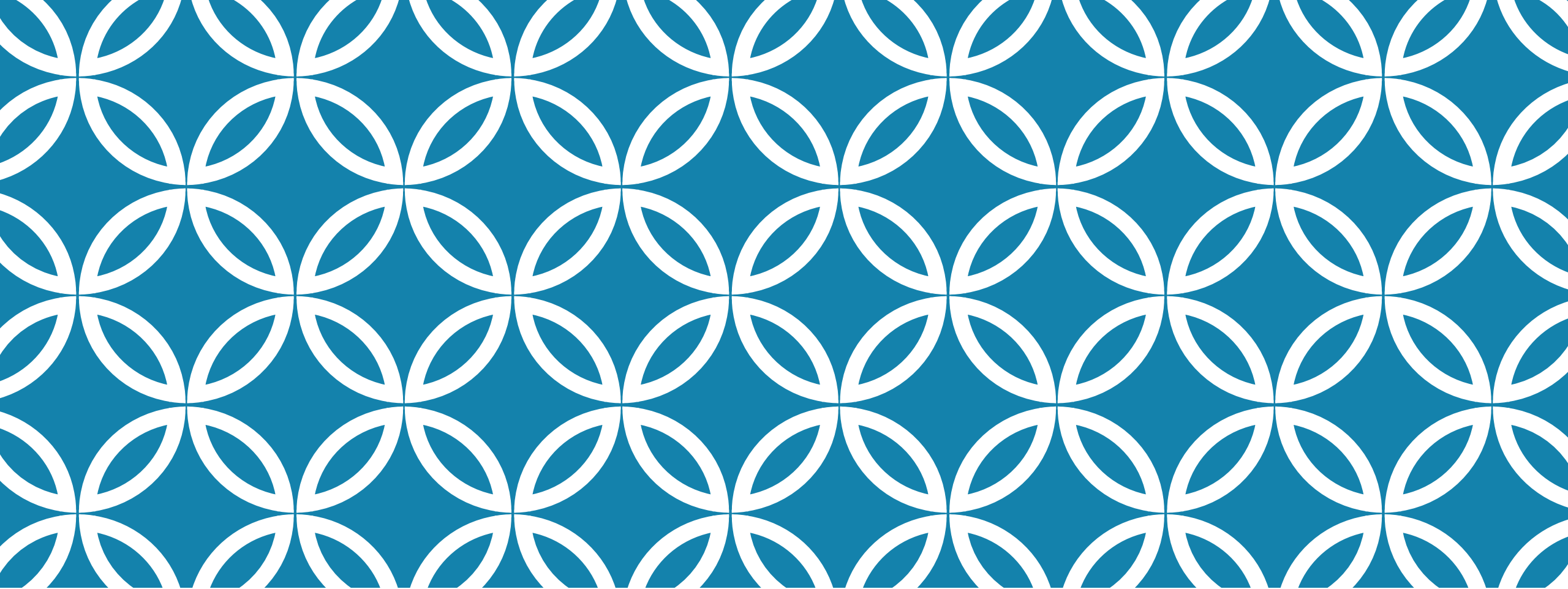
GOD'S WORD AND MY LIFE
