





a.) Original Sin: Adam's sin counts for all people of all time



c.) The sinful nature\*\* inside us is always hostile to God's will


\*\*Also called the old self, old man, flesh, old way of life, etc.


b.) This new heart knows and loves doing God's will

### What is the result of my having both a sinful nature and a new heart?


Galatians 5:17 // Galatians 2:20

### God's Word and My Life Evaluate: Because every person is born with a sinful nature, every Christian is capable of committing any sin.



Evaluate. When one of the comic sections in the newspaper pictures a person with a devil on one shoulder urging him to do something bad and an angel on the other shoulder telling him to do something good, this is a good picture of the struggle that goes on in us between our sinful nature and our new heart.



# What is God impressing on us by telling us not to covet?

By telling us not to covet God is impressing on us that the sinful desires brought about in our hearts by the sinful nature with which we were born are sin and condemn us.
