Genesis 2 = $\underline{zooms in on most important}$ $\underline{events of day 6}$



- Psalm 104:15-16 The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food at the proper time. You open your hand and satisfy the desires of every living thing.







- To show him he was unique and alone




LAW


