




Connecting to **HIS**tory



- The Serpent: <u>Satan</u>, the leader of the fallen rebellious angels, took the form of a serpent to tempt Adam and Eve
 - Revelation 12:9 The great dragon was hurled down—
 that ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, who leads
 the whole world astray.

- Cain: the firstborn son of Adam and Eve, an unbeliever, who murdered his brother, Abel
- Abel: a later son of Adam and Eve, a believer
- Seth: another son of Adam and Eve, also a believer, the line of the Savior was carried on through him


Where?


Eden and nearby territory to the east

- Can't say with absolute certainty, but based on genealogies in the Bible likely between 7000 -10,000 years ago




Hebrews 11:3 Without faith it is impossible to please God.



LAW






LAW

- God's commands, threats, punishments...
 - -Adam and Eve have guilt, fear of God
 - God curses them and their descendants for their disobedience (pain, death, forced to leave Eden)
 - -God condemns Cain to being a wanderer

GOSPEL

- God's mercy, forgiveness, goodness, and promises...
 - God does not condemn Adam and Eve to hell but promises a Savior
 - —God does not allow anyone to kill Cain, though he deserved it
 - —God gives Adam and Eve another son
