




- Daughters of men (6:2) = the daughters of unbelievers
- The Nephilim (6:4) = comes from a Hebrew word meaning "to attack." The well-known heroes of the time were known for their violence and oppression of others.




LAW

- God's commands, threats, punishments...
 - -The Flood destroys ALL life on earth
 - —God condemns all people as evil/sinful from childhood
 - Allowance for capital punishment in the post-Flood world

Gospel


- God's mercy, forgiveness, goodness, and promises...
 - —God saves Noah and his family (and the animals)
 - —God (unconditionally) promises to never send another flood


