LAW or GOSPEL?



Directions: In the following Scripture passages write law or gospel in the blank after each phrase or verse stating whether you think it is law or gospel.

Remember that in the Law God makes demands and punishes disobedience.

The Gospel shows us God's free forgiveness, mercy, and promises in Christ.

Examples:

Luke 2:10-11 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord." (GOSPEL)

2 Samuel 12:13-14 Then David said to Nathan, "I have sinned against the LORD." (LAW)
Nathan replied, "The LORD has taken away your sin. You are not going to die. (GOSPEL)
But because by doing this you have made the enemies of the LORD show utter contempt, the son born to you will die." (LAW)

Exodus 34:6-7 And [the LORD] passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. () Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children and their children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation." ()

Galatians 3:11 Clearly no one is justified before God by the law (), because, "The righteous will live by faith." ()

2 Timothy 3:15 How from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. ()

Romans 1:16 I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes. ()

Romans 2:22a-23 There is no difference, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. ()
