- 1. Read (or listen to an audio reading) the passage a minimum of five times.
- 2. Write out the chapter word for word in your own handwriting.
- 3. Choose one of the following assignments every week:
  - Memorize 3 verses from the assigned passage.
  - Paraphrase the passage (put it in your own words) in a paragraph.
  - Draw a picture, do a piece of artwork, or write a poem that describes the passage or what the passage means.
  - Discuss the passage with someone before you come.
  - Do an in-depth word study for three words in the passage.
  - Listen to a sermon on the passage and take notes.
  - Outline the passage (must be different than the outline in their Bible.)
- 4. Bring your Bible, the assignment you chose, and your handwritten copy of the passage with you.
- 5. Come ready to share and answer the following:
  - What assignment did you choose and why?
  - What is this passage saying?
  - What do I need to do with it?
- 6. Come ready to share a personal prayer request regarding your own spiritual growth.
- 7. A student is allowed <u>one</u> absence from the meetings and must notify their Life Group leader if they will miss.
