## SEE WHAT GOD HAS DONE



### MARIETTA COMMUNITY HOUSE

Located on West Market Street in Marietta, this was the first building used as a place of worship by our congregation. We also used the building directly behind it as our congregation continued to grow. (1951-1965)



### CONGREGATIONAL BIBLE CHURCH

In November 1965, we had our first worship service in our new building along Route 441.



### CONGREGATIONAL BIBLE CHURCH: NEW SANCTUARY

As we continued to grow, a new sanctuary was constructed and the previous one was remodeled into classrooms. The new sanctuary was dedicated to the service and glory of God in October 1980.



### COMMUNITY BIBLE CHURCH

The need for additional space was felt through the 1990s and a process began in 2001 that would ultimately result in the construction of a new campus located across Route 441 on the hill. Our first Sunday was in March 2007.

### NEW LIFE BIBLE CHURCH

Now, in 2026, through the leading of the Holy Spirit, we are set to launch our first new church with Pastor Nate King this spring!

# THE Ripple Effect

# OF A **LIFE** transformed **CRAIG &** **MARISA'S** **STORY**

**"I found CBC after a failed attempt at taking my own life." Feeling hopeless and desperate for change, Craig searched online for local churches and came across CBC. Though he had never been close to God, something compelled him to attend one Sunday. The very next day, he attended re:generation at CBC.**



Walking into CBC, Craig was a very broken man with a life in chaos and a marriage steaming toward divorce. "Every song unleashed a tidal wave of emotion. I felt sad, but I also felt the comfort of love and belonging. I hung on every word of the message and thought, 'This message is for me.'" The honesty of the church, the music, and the message kept him coming back.

In re:generation, Craig learned to lower his walls, be vulnerable, and speak openly for the first time. He discovered he was not alone. Instead of judgment, he found encouragement, healing, and hope. ***During re:generation, Craig gave his life to Jesus.***

**Marisa's spiritual journey** began long before CBC. She grew up in the Catholic Church, but was skeptical when Craig suddenly began attending CBC after years of refusing to go to church with her. But since Craig was attending CBC, she noticed real change in Craig as he became softer, less angry, and more present with their family. Because of this, Marisa decided to attend CBC with Craig.

She says, "My first impression of CBC was, 'Wow! This is nothing like the Catholic Church.' I loved the music, and I felt comfortable and seen." Soon, Marisa began attending re:generation herself and now has a community of women surrounding her.

Today, while far from perfect, their marriage is no longer unequally yoked. Their marriage is healing, and they "are more of a team than we have ever been" and "becoming closer than we've been in a long time." Together, they walk as a team, knowing that Christ saved Craig's life and restored their family. "I don't think I would have a life if it weren't for Jesus. I probably wouldn't be here today."


## ANDREW'S STORY

Andrew was introduced to the student ministry at CBC through friends in sixth grade, but it wasn't until a year ago that he fully gave his life to Jesus.

After years of living "on the fence" and chasing things that left him empty, Andrew realized he needed real change. By attending Student Body on Wednesdays, Sunday mornings, and re:generation, he found a community of guys who pushed him to live like Jesus.

Before surrendering to Christ, Andrew lacked direction and fulfillment, carrying his struggles alone. Through Christ, he has discovered a new identity, a new purpose, and a new source of strength. Now he desires to live honestly, love others well, and serve

something bigger than himself. Jesus has given him that purpose. He began a Bible study group within his Donegal Baseball Team and shares Jesus with those on the golf course and in the halls of Donegal High School.



# LIVES transformed

## JANET & MACIE'S STORY

Janet reached the lowest point of her life after years of quiet, destructive choices. One Sunday, she slipped into church with her head down, hoping to hide, aching for relief from shame and anxiety. But through CBC and re:generation, God slowly untangled her divided life. On June 17, 2023, she surrendered her life to Jesus, discovering freedom she never thought possible, supported by women who prayed, challenged, and walked beside her.

Her estranged daughter, Macie, was fighting her own unseen war. Haunted by abuse and family pain, she tried to disappear through an eating disorder and self-harm, believing she was a mistake. After a suicide attempt left her angry and empty, darkness followed her everywhere. Yet God pursued her relentlessly through people who loved her at her worst and reminded her of the truth.



As Janet healed, Macie watched shame fall from her mother's shoulders and decided to see where these changes in her mom came from. Macie began attending CBC, and together they have now found a church family that welcomes scars without judgment, anchors them in Scripture, and teaches them to look forward, not back. Their broken relationship was restored, turning distance into trust.

Without Jesus, neither believe they would still be alive today.

## What if we do nothing?

As we give thanks for all that God is doing, it's important to ask: **“What if we do nothing?”** Without the growth of God's work at CBC, imagine the void left behind. The youth, struggling to navigate life's complexities, would be left without Christ's guidance. Marriages would continue to fracture. Addictions would run rampant. Local schools would suffer from a lack of hope, support, and restoration in people's lives. Our communities would remain in darkness. People would not experience the transformative power of God.

# Creative WAYS to Give

As you pray about your commitment to **next75**, we invite you to ask the Lord how He might lead you to give in ways that reflect both faith and joy. It's possible that He may prompt you to give creatively or in a way you had not considered before. The goal is not equal gifts, but equal surrender. We are trusting God to speak personally to each of us about what sacrifice looks like in our own lives. As we listen and obey, He will take our collective offerings—large and small—and multiply them for His glory and the transformation of lives for generations to come.

## **1. Designate Tax Refunds or Bonus Income**

For the next three years, prayerfully commit all or a portion of your income tax refunds, work bonuses, or unexpected financial blessings. These “unplanned” resources can become intentional gifts dedicated to advancing God’s work through next75.

## **2. Sacrifice a Regular Comfort**

Choose something meaningful to you—a streaming service, frequent dining out, a vacation upgrade, a hobby expense—and redirect those funds to the campaign. A small monthly sacrifice over three years becomes a powerful investment in future generations.

## **3. Sell Something of Value**

Consider selling an item that has value but is no longer essential—a recreational item, unused equipment, collectibles, or secondary vehicle—and joyfully give the proceeds. Turning possessions into ministry impact is a tangible way to say, “This matters more.”

## **4. Commit to Percentage Giving From Side Income**

Dedicate a percentage of side jobs, freelance work, business income, or seasonal work over the next three years (for example, 10–50%). As God blesses this additional work, those blessings flow directly to the next75 initiatives.

## **5. Delay a Purchase**

Postpone a significant purchase—home renovation, technology upgrade, furniture replacement, vacation—and give toward the campaign instead. Waiting now helps create space and ministry for those who will come later.

## **6. Investment Gifts**

Giving shares of stock or mutual funds can be a desireable way to give. By giving the investment before you sell it, you can avoid capital gains taxes and may receive a tax deduction for the full market value of your gift.


