How to Submit Money

SUPPORT RAISING

We believe that depending on God through the financial and prayer support of the Body of Christ is very beneficial.

Writing a Prayer Support Letter

1. Even if you plan to pay for the entire trip yourself, you are still required to write a prayer letter.
2. Students will be taught how to write a prayer support letter in one of the Training Meetings using a provided form letter.
3. Students will be given a supply of support cards and giving envelopes.
4. Students are responsible for distributing their support letters with a support card and giving envelope.

Students will be updated regularly regarding their support total.

EXPECTATIONS

Below are expectations for students to apply and be accepted to participate in Youth Summer Trips. Failure to meet these expectations may result in being denied acceptance or removal from the team.

Students are expected to...

1. Attend Student Body (Sunday morning or Wednesday night) at least 2/3 of the year.
2. Show evidence of being spiritually born again and live their life in a way that honors Christ both publicly and privately.
3. Complete all necessary paperwork and forms by noted deadlines.
4. Submit all payments by noted deadlines.
5. Attend all training meetings and complete all given assignments. The student is expected to contact the trip leader if they cannot attend a training meeting and to complete and submit any assignments due before the missed meeting. (Note: Failure to attend a minimum of 2/3 of training meetings may result in removal from the team.)
6. Work well with peers and leaders and show evidence of humility and cooperation.
