1. What is significant about the Hebrew wording regarding the creation of the world?
Hebrew: yom
 - When used with a number, always means 24-hour day.
 - Additionally, the phrase “evening and morning” always means 24 hours.
 - The plural form of yom is yamim and always means 24 hours.
2. What are your thoughts about the large number and variety of dragon legends from all over the world?
3. Do you struggle with the idea that man and dinosaurs lived together? If so, is this based on Scripture or the ideas in our culture?
4. What is significant about finding “fresh tissue” within dinosaur fossils?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 15:12-26. Was Paul talking about Jesus’ resurrection from physical or spiritual death?
6. What is significant about verses 21-22?
7. Since death is a result of man’s sin, and death is an enemy (verse 26), is it reasonable to believe that there was death in the world prior to Adam sinning?
8. Additionally, why is it significant that God declared that all He had made was “very good” (Genesis 1:31) in regard to the timing of death and disease?
