ALL THAT IS DONE WITHIN THE BODY OF CHRIST THAT IS A PART OF THE MINISTRY OF HELPS IS A "VITAL PART" OF THE WORK OF THE MINISTRY. HELPS IS A MINISTRY TO THE LORD.

1. WE ARE ALL OF THE SAME BODY, BUT WE ARE MEMBERS INDIVIDUALLY.
(1 COR 12:27-31)
A. No one member or gift is any better than another. Every $\qquad$ is important to the body.
B. God Himself supernaturally set the ministry of helps in the $\qquad$ .
C. We are not all called to be apostles or prophets, but we are all in the ministry of helps to some $\qquad$ _.

## 2. THERE ARE THREE BASIC DEGREES OF HELPS.

A. Doing those things that the $\qquad$ has no ability to do.
B. Doing those things that the pastor can do but should not be doing because he needs to be fulfilling his $\qquad$ to the body.
C. Doing those things that the pastor is doing but needs you to do them
$\qquad$ him.

## 3. EVERY MEMBER IS NO LESS CALLED THAN THEIR PASTOR. (1 COR 12:12-18)

A. God calls you to a shepherd, and therefore to the body connected to that shepherd. As a part of that body He has a place for you to $\qquad$ .
B. Every member is $\qquad$ just as every member of our natural body has a specific function.

## 4. WE ARE NOT WORKING "FOR" GOD, BUT WORKING "WITH" GOD. (2 COR 6:1)

A. When we are involved in a church body as a part of the ministry of helps we become workers $\qquad$ with God.
B. Vain - Fruitless or without effect.
C. To receive God's gift of grace in vain would mean to become born again, but never get involved in making an impact for God as a $\qquad$ of the body of Christ.
