Small Group Q&A – A Follower of Jesus - Believes

Text: Psalm 20:7, John 17:8, James 1:22

Sermon Reflection

Pastor Stephen reminded us that Jesus isn't an addition to life, He *is* life. True belief goes beyond words—it is trust, acceptance, and action. Our lives become the testimony of whether following Jesus really leads to life.

1. Jesus is life itself.

What does it mean to you that Jesus is not just part of your life but the very source of it? (How does this truth change the way you see your daily decisions?)

2. Trust and acceptance.

Psalm 20:7 calls us to trust in the name of the Lord. In what areas of your life is it hardest to fully trust Jesus?

(Where is He inviting you to let go and accept His way?)

3. Belief leads to action.

James says faith without works is dead. Where do you see a gap between what you believe and what you do?

(What steps could you take this week to close that gap?)

4. Actions that reveal belief.

John 17:8 shows that receiving and obeying Jesus' words is part of belief. How do your actions reveal what you truly believe about Him?

(What one action could you take this week that shows trust in Him?)

5. Prayer & Community

Pray that your group would live out belief in Jesus not only with words, but through trust, acceptance, and actions.

(Ask God to help you be living testimonies that show others the life found only in Him.)
