Small Group Q&A - Red Letter Edition Pt. 8

The Father Revealed – Matthew 7:11; 5:46; 6:4; 11:27; Romans 8:16

Sermon Reflection

Jesus came to reveal the true nature of God the Father. Through His teaching, we see that the Father is caring, generous, merciful, compassionate, present, and fully revealed in the Son.

Personal Application / Understanding the Message

- 1. Jesus shows us that God is a caring and generous Father (Matthew 7:11). How does this truth affect the way you pray or trust Him with your daily needs? (Are there specific areas in your life where you need to lean more on the Father's care and generosity?)
- Jesus reveals that the Father is merciful and compassionate, even to the undeserving (Matthew 5:46). How can you reflect this character of God toward people who are difficult to love? (What practical steps could you take to extend compassion beyond those who treat you well?)
- 3. Father God sees and hears you (Matthew 6:4). How does knowing that He is always present encourage you when you feel unseen or unheard by others? (In what situations do you most need to be reminded that God is near?)
- 4. Jesus invites us to find rest in the Father's presence (Matthew 11:27–28). Where do you need to trade striving for rest today? (What does it look like for you to find true satisfaction in being with the Father rather than chasing the world's approval?)

Prayer & Community

5. Romans 8:16 says the Spirit bears witness that God is our Father. How can your group remind one another of this truth throughout the week?

(Pray together for deeper trust, greater awareness of the Father's love, and rest in His presence.)
