## St. Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist

The Anglican celebration of St. Matthew, observed annually on September 21st, honors the apostle's dramatic transformation from a despised tax collector to a devoted follower of Christ and author of the first Gospel. (The Anglican Compass)

## St. Michael and all Angels

The Anglican celebration of St. Michael and All Angels, also known as Michaelmas, is a rich and symbolic feast observed annually on September 29th.

The feast emphasizes the victory of good over evil, with St. Michael as the heavenly warrior who defeats Satan in the biblical war in heaven (Revelation 12:7– 9).

In Anglican theology, angels are seen as messengers and servants of God, created as pure spirits before the material world.

# The Book of Common Prayer A Penitential Office for Ash Wednesday

The **Penitential Office for Ash Wednesday** in the Anglican tradition is a solemn liturgical rite that marks the beginning of **Lent**, a season of repentance, fasting, and spiritual renewal.


The Penitential Office has its roots in the **Commination Service** of the 1549 *Book of Common Prayer*, which itself adapted ancient rites said between Prime and Mass on Ash Wednesday.

The term "Commination" refers to the public declaration of God's judgments against sin, intended to inspire repentance.

Influenced by reformers like **Martin Bucer**, the service emphasized **corporate confession** and the revival of **public penance**. (northamanglican.com)
