TIME

Parents, build intentional time into the rhythm of family life for the purpose of thinking about, talking about, and living out the gospel. Use the guide below for family worship.

READ

John 1:19–34; Isaiah 40:3–5

- Who is John the Baptist and what did he do?
- How did John the Baptist prepare the way for the Promised Savior?
- What is repentance?
- How does John the Baptist fulfill the Old Testament prophecy that we see in Isaiah 40:3–5?
- What does this story teach us about God?
- What does this story show us about ourselves?

PRAY

Take turns praying together.

- **Praise:** God, You are... (refer to His attributes)
- **Thanksgiving:** God, I thank you for...
- **Lament:** God, I am sad about...
- **Confession:** God, forgive me for... and help me forgive...
- **Request:** God, I ask you for...

SING

Play your favorite worship songs and sing together. Make up motions to your favorite parts!



Moments

Read the parable of the unforgiving servant from Matthew 18 together. Talk about specific ways that you struggle with sin over and over again, and how God is faithful to forgive His children. Throughout the week, look for opportunities to forgive others in the way that Christ has forgiven His children.
