Make a bracelet with any materials you have that will help you remember this promise.</p>	<p>Have each family member share a time when they didn't keep a promise to someone.</p> <p>READ: Genesis 18:1-5, 21:1-6</p> <p>ASK: What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p>Sept 21-27</p> <p>Go over this week's CONVERSATION STARTERS.</p> <p>You can find them on the "Sundays this Month" page on the app/website.</p>	<p>READ: Numbers 23:19</p> <p>ASK: What does this verse tell us about God?</p>	<p>Have a family treat ready to go. Set a timer for 3-5 minutes and have everyone wait to enjoy the treat. Discuss how hard it can be to wait.</p>	<p>MEMORIZE: Psalm 18:30a</p> <p>ASK: What does it mean that the word of the Lord proves true?</p>	<p>Play Jenga or something similar. Discuss how we can always count on God's promises, like a structure that never falls.</p>	<p>Have each family member share a high, low, and something random from their day.</p> <p>READ: Genesis 42-45 or a book about Joseph's story.</p> <p>ASK: What does this teach us about God?</p>
<p>Sept 28-Oct 4</p> <p>Go over this week's CONVERSATION STARTERS.</p> <p>You can find them on the "Sundays this Month" page on the app/website.</p>	<p>READ: Genesis 50:20</p> <p>ASK: What bad things happened to Joseph that turned out good?</p>	<p>Make fresh lemonade without sugar. Explain that God takes things that can be bad and makes them good. Add sugar to the lemonade and drink it.</p>	<p>MEMORIZE: Psalm 18:30a</p> <p>ASK: Do you trust that God has a perfect plan for you? Why or why not?</p>	<p>Discuss any bad situations you're facing. Talk about how God could bring good from it. Pray and ask God for help.</p>	<p>ASK: If you were a king or queen, what's one rule you'd make?</p> <p>READ: Exodus 19-20 or a book about the 10 commandments.</p> <p>ASK: What does this teach us about God?</p>
