We would like to share an important prayer update from Corner Fringe Ministries India Children's Home. One of our children, Kumar, is currently facing a health challenge related to his ear.

Kumar is suffering from an eardrum hole problem, which has been causing discharge (pus) from his ear. He is under medical care, and we are faithfully following the doctor's advice. At this time, Kumar is taking prescribed medicines, and the doctor has advised us to wait until the discharge completely stops. Only after that will the doctors be able to proceed with the required surgery.

This is a difficult and uncomfortable time for Kumar, but we trust in God's healing hand. We kindly request you to remember Kumar in your prayers—for relief from pain, complete healing, and for the upcoming surgery to be successful at the right time. Please also pray for wisdom for the doctors and strength and peace for Kumar during this waiting period.

We are grateful for your continued prayers, love, and support for our children. Together, we place Kumar's health and future into the loving hands of our Heavenly Father.

1. We would like to share an important and prayerful update regarding one of our associated ministers, Pastor Krupamma. While Pastor Krupamma was courageously serving the Lord through street evangelism in a nearby village, an unfortunate and painful incident occurred. A person suddenly approached her and violently kicked her right leg, resulting in a serious hip injury. She experienced intense pain and immediately reached out to us for help. Upon receiving her call, we shared the matter with our board and spent time in earnest prayer, seeking God's wisdom and guidance. By God's grace, and through the loving support of our CFM family, arrangements were made for her hip surgery, which—by the mercy of the Lord—went very well.

We are deeply grateful for every prayer, every act of compassion, and every hand that came together to support Pastor Krupamma during this critical time. We humbly ask you to continue praying for her complete recovery, for strength and peace for her family, and for God's healing touch to rest upon her.

Regarding the incident, a police case was filed; however, due to the individual's political background, the case has not progressed. Even so, as followers of Yeshua, we choose the path of grace. We lift that person into the hands of Yeshua, praying that God's love would transform hearts and bring true repentance and peace. This incident reminds us that the work of the Gospel often comes with trials, yet the Lord remains faithful. As Scripture says, *"The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit"* (Psalm 34:18).

2. I would like to joyfully share a new ministry update. By God's grace, I, Vijay, am now working as a taxi driver, and this has opened a beautiful new door for ministry. Through daily travels, I am now able to spend more time in street evangelism, especially with my co-travelers and passengers. As we journey together, I share Gospel tracts with them. Many take time to read them, and when questions or doubts arise, it becomes a wonderful opportunity to lovingly explain the Good News and begin meaningful evangelism conversations.

These simple moments on the road have become powerful times of witnessing and planting seeds of faith. I am truly thankful and happy to see how God is using even my daily work as a platform to spread His Word. This reminds me that ministry can happen anywhere—when our hearts are willing and led by the Holy Spirit.

I humbly request you to please keep me in your prayers—for wisdom, boldness, protection during travel, and that every seed sown will bear fruit in God's perfect time.

Preach the message; be persistent in doing so, whether in season or out of season convince, reprove, and encourage, but with great patience and instruction.

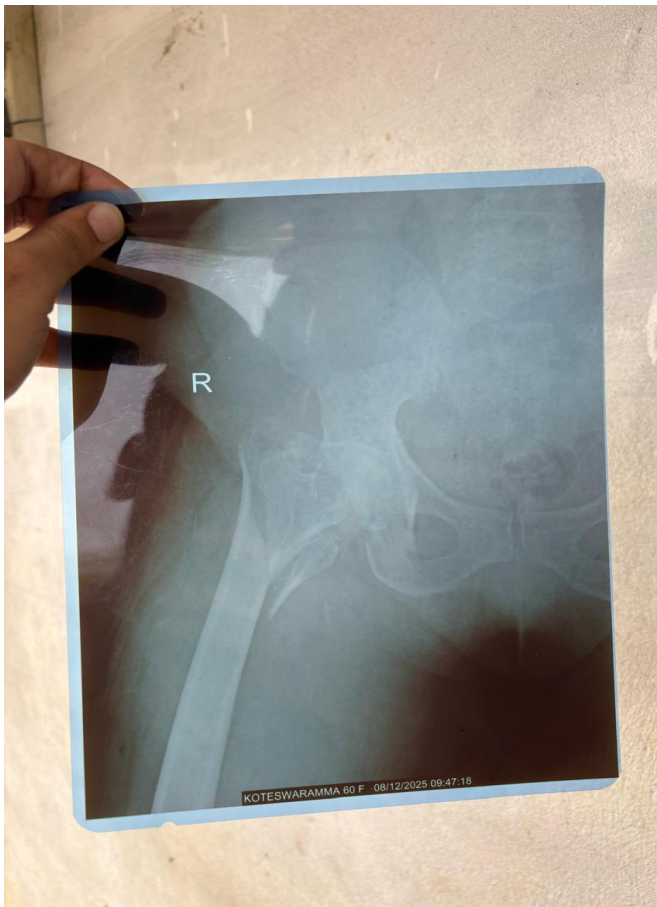

CFMI NEW BUILDING UPDATE

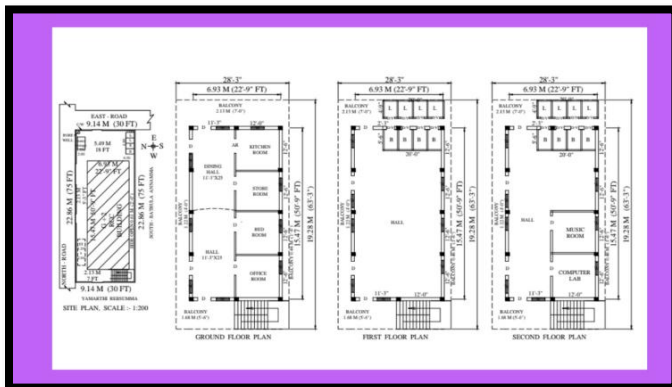
“Unless the Lord builds the house, they labor in vain who build it.” – Psalm 127:1
