

# On Salt and Light

The end time events foretold in the books of Timothy, Matthew, Peter and elsewhere in the

Bible have already begun. Consider 2Tim 3:1-7: "But know this: Hard times will come in the last days. For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful,



proud, demeaning, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy, unloving, irreconcilable, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, without love for what is good, traitors, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, holding to the form of godliness but denying its power."

Or 1Tim 4:1-3: "Now the Spirit explicitly says that in later times some will depart from the faith, paying attention to deceitful spirits and the teachings of demons, through the hypocrisy of liars whose consciences are seared. They forbid marriage and demand abstinence from foods that God created to be received with gratitude by those who believe and know the truth."



Another prophecy that seals the deal that we are in the end times is Daniel 12:4: "But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased." Never in history have so many people traveled. Never has so much knowledge been gathered.

Something else is occurring with all of these prophetic events: fewer Americans believe in the existence of God than ever. I believe that God is separating in the world those who are or will be his children from those who won't.

Mat 3:12: "He is ready to separate the chaff from the wheat with his winnowing fork. Then he will clean up the threshing area, gathering the wheat into his barn but burning the chaff with never-ending fire."

Mat 13:48: "When the net was full, they dragged it up onto the shore, sat down, and sorted the good fish into crates, but threw the bad ones away."

We see this great separating process taking place within the church as well. The nogathering mandates during the pandemic forced most churches to suspend in-person services. Once the restrictions were lifted, many who had attended never returned. Church attendance in the Christian community now is at the lowest percentage ever seen in America.

James 2:20 describes the condition of those who are believers but who have opted out of going to church, serving in ministry, studying the Bible, tithing, and so on: "Faith without works is dead." That doesn't mean the man who isn't living out his faith is unsaved but that he is useless, like a worker sleeping on the job. He's still an employee, just not a useful one.

Those who profess to be Christians but who are casual in following and obeying Jesus may find it increasingly hard to be neither hot nor cold. God loves each of us and keeps trying to get our attention when we ignore his desires for our life. Christians who keep the faith but do nothing with it continually hear the Holy Spirit rapping on the door of their conscience. Those who continue not to answer the door do so at their peril, for God will have his way with us, one way or another. Consider what Jesus said in Mat 5:13: "You are the salt of the earth. But what good is salt if it has lost its flavor? Can you make it salty again? It will be thrown out and trampled underfoot as worthless."

Take God's admonitions seriously, for these are the final days before the Rapture and Tribulation. We will all stand before him one day to give an account of what we have done. Decide now that you want to be his salt and light in this dark world. Remember the words of Joshua 24:15: "But as for me and my family, we will serve the LORD."
