2. What stands out to you as you read through the passage?
3. Read Ephesians 1:15-22 and consider the strength that God has displayed. What does it mean for us to be strengthened In light of what God has shown us?
4. Is there anything that is able to overcome us in light of what God has done? Why or why not?
5. What do we learn about the enemy in this passage? Who is the enemy?
6. Consider all we have learned in the book of Ephesians. What have we already learned about the enemy and how does this passage help us understand all that we have seen?
7. Do you ever pray on the armor of God in your own life? Why or why not?
8. Why does Paul command us to wear the armor?
9. What would it look like for you to start putting on the armor each day?
10. How would it change how you approach relationships with other believers if you took seriously the call to put on the armor each day?
11. Do you consider your need to put the armor on in the following areas:
  - a. When you wake up?
  - b. When you get to work?
  - c. When you get home from work?
  - d. When you visit friends or family?
  - e. When you come to church?
  - f. When you watch a TV show?
  - g. When you are on your phone?
  - h. When you go for a walk?
  - i. When you are reading a long list (note, this one is a joke, but really...Do you consider putting on the armor everywhere including when you show up to this Bible study?)
12. Take some time to end in prayer by sharing prayer requests and praying for one another.
