- Middle School program returned to PCS in the fall with the addition of a seventh grade.
- Mrs. Aleea Armijo joined our Administration as an Assistant Principal in October 2022.
- New Ocean Pines fall trip was scheduled for seventh graders.
- Robotics Team was established in the fall of 2022.
- Family Life Seminars were introduced to help support parents.
- Dr. Michael Foell joined the team as our daily Campus Pastor.
- A separate Middle School chapel was established to help meet the spiritual needs of upper-grade students.

- Middle School Worship team was started under the direction of Mrs. Ens.
- Student Success Teams (SST) process was established to meet student needs.
- Online Spirit Store was launched.
- Wholesome Foods became the food vendor for PCS in the fall of 2022.
- Ms. Borjas became the Student Life Advisor and Middle School Bible teacher for the 22/23 school year.
- ERC application was filed in 2023 to support the Employee Retention Credit.



- PCS received the Best in Santa Maria Award in 2023 in the Private Elementary School Category for the third year in a row.
- Student enrollment increased significantly in all grade levels for the third consecutive year.
- Two new portable buildings were purchased to add two new classrooms in the fall of 2023.
- Sixth Grade students enjoyed another week-long trip to Hume Lake in the Spring of 2023,
- After School Art Program returned for the second consecutive year.
- After School childcare hours were extended to 5:00 pm.
- Jacob Knight Shade Structure was relocated to make room for new portable classrooms.

- The playground wood chips were replenished and the blacktop resurfaced and restriped.
- PTF was reestablished in 2022 with an active and productive group of parent volunteers.
- The PCS Quest Auction returned and raised \$131,000 for the school.
- Our Annual Family Preference Week closed with a 90% retention rate and record number of new families enrolling.
- Pacific Christian School will welcome over 380 students in the fall, up from 320 in 2022.
- Shield a Badge Program with Santa Maria Police Department enters its third straight year praying for every police officer by name, daily.
