Festival hours are:

Saturday, 9/16 from noon–11:00pm
Sunday, 9/17 from noon–7:00pm, with the carnival closing Sunday at 8:00pm.

Parking is available for festival attendees at Lakeview Center and limited parking is available compliments of our friends at Abbott Molecular.

Of course, fest-goers will also be using neighborhood street parking. In an effort to inform fest-goers as they leave their vehicles, you may see Fall Fest yard signs in your parkway from Friday through Monday.

A combination of Des Plaines Police, Contracted Security Officers and Park District staff will remain on-site to provide security during festival hours, and overnight Thursday through Monday.
