PROCESS OF ENTRY

1. Grading

Performers must appear on the finalised [2026 Solo Grading Lists](#) to be eligible to compete in the 2026 solo season. **No further changes will be made to the grading lists.**

Exceptions:

- Duos and Trios will be graded after entries are received, where participant numbers allow.
- Duo grading will be based on the calisthenics solo grading of both performers.
- Interstate performers will not appear on the 2026 Solo Grading List. They must apply for a grading to be eligible to enter Metro or Regional competitions. Grading will be determined after entry.
- Recreational performers are not required to be on the grading list to enter Recreational competitions.
- CaliStars performers are not required to be on the grading list to enter CaliStars competitions. However, to enter Metro or Regional competitions, performers must appear on the official grading list.

3. Registration Process

Registration Opens: **Monday 10th November 2025.**

All performers and coaches must be registered with Calisthenics Victoria (CaliVic) for the 2026 season as only current, registered members are eligible to enter competitions.

2. Registration Fees

Registration fees are reviewed and set annually by CaliVic.

3. Competition Entries

Competition entries open: **10th November 2025.**

Competition entries close: **30th November 2025 at 11:59 pm.**

No late entries accepted

Payment Schedule:

- 50% of total payment is due upon entry submission.
- Full payment must be received by 13 January 2026.
- Payment method: Credit or debit card only.
- Online Transactions fees apply.

4. Entry Fees

Entry fees are reviewed annually by Calisthenics Victoria.

Entry fees for solos competitions in 2026:

Entry fee includes one audience ticket per performer and a coach pass.

5. Refunds

- The Calisthenics Victoria membership registration fee is non-refundable. This fee covers administration and insurance costs for all members.
- Requests for refunds under extraordinary circumstances must be emailed in writing with supporting documents to admin@calisthenics.asn.au.
- Competition refunds (less a \$10 administration fee) after entries close are only granted if a valid medical certificate is provided and the official [Refund Request Form](#) is submitted within 48 hours of the scheduled performance.
- Refunds may be granted in cases of unavoidable performance clashes (e.g. multiple solo performances by the same competitor). Requests must be submitted to Calisthenics Victoria at least two weeks prior to the affected event.
- No other refunds will be offered once entries have closed.

6. Venues, Dates & Schedules

- 2026 competition venues, session dates and detailed performer schedules will be released early in 2026.
- Information will be distributed via the CaliVic website.
- Schedules will include session times, venue risk management information, and performer arrival requirements.

7. Scheduling

- Metro competitions: We are unable to offer the opportunity for entrants to select their competition host at the time of entries, as allocations are based on entries received
- Regional competitions: Performers can select the competition/region in which they want to attend
- Weekends for State Championships: Based on entries received, competitors will need to wait for the schedule to find out when they are scheduled.
- Clashes with siblings, coaching, classes cannot be considered when scheduling and refunds are not offered for clashes in schedules.
- Clashes with other solo types are taken into account when scheduling as much as possible, should a clash be unavoidable a refund will be offered for the solo type that cannot be attended
- Sections (except Open) will be split at Local and State championships when they reach more than:
 - 5-17 yrs: 20 Soloists
 - 18 yrs, Seniors, Masters: 25 Soloists

8. Stage Sizes

Please note stage sizes vary across venues. Venues will be allocated with consideration to performer age and division.

9. Music

Music will be required to be uploaded to the performer's MyCompHQ portals by the Sunday prior to competition weekend. Registered coaches will now also be able to access, through the coaches portal, their

performer's competition entries and upload their music. If music is not uploaded a performer will not be allowed to compete at that competition.

10. Photography and Videography

Information regarding performance videos and photography will be communicated early 2026.

11. Ticket Prices/Admission

Information regarding ticket pricing and conditions of admission will be communicated early 2026.
