The LSCP recommends a programme of multi-agency safeguarding training for all practitioners.

This runs alongside your own single agency safeguarding training.



- The courses are delivered via a combination of eLearning, virtual workshops and face to face training on a rolling programme. Once the pathway is completed please start again at year 1.
- The pathway is designed to help you develop safeguarding knowledge, making it important to start at year 1. However, you may choose to complete other courses at different times depending on the needs of the children and families you work with.
- Participants can select the most relevant course for their practice needs, but please note the conditions for course entry (prerequisites). It is important these are completed as all courses build on the prerequisites.
- Courses with an orange star  indicate minimum safeguarding training for Designated Safeguarding Leads over a 6 year period. However, all other LSCP training demonstrates a commitment to safeguarding children and young people.
- It is recommended that those in regular contact with children and young people also attend the [Early Help Consultant workshops, forums and supervision](#) sessions to enhance knowledge and support continued professional development.
