

Afterschool Program Description

CPRPD After School Camp (ASC) will offer limited availability to K-6th grade participants for qualified supervision when school lets out until **5:15pm Mon - Friday**. This offer excludes holidays or School Break days as referenced on the school calendar. The program is offered for 5-days per week full-time attendance-part time ASC participation is not supported.

The program will offer the following services during ASC hours:

- Homework / Tutoring (*small group*)
- Healthy Snack
- Enrichment Opportunities such as physical play, arts and crafts, and table games

Cancellation / Early Release Disclaimer

When unforeseen circumstances occur, ASC may be canceled, or an early release called. CPRPD will strive to provide as much advance notice as possible in every circumstance, but Parents/Guardians acknowledge that advance notice may not be possible. Participants must be picked up immediately when an Early Release is called, or directly after school lets out when ASC is canceled for an entire day or days.

Guidelines and Behavior Expectations

- Students must adhere to the Guidelines and Behavior expectations listed below.
- Students cannot exhibit unsafe, disrespectful behavior to staff or other participants.
- Participants must be picked up no later than **5:15pm** by a Parent/Guardian, Emergency Contact, or Authorized Pick-Up person.
- Absences from the program greater than three days per month will result in consideration for dismissal from ASC. Exceptions for illness and scheduled extracurricular activities.

Dismissal from ASP

We place high importance on student conduct and we hold our students to a high standard of behavior, honesty, responsibility, kindness, and fairness. Older students set the example for younger students who will watch and mimic behavior. We ask our families to discuss with their students the conduct and behavior standards expected from them.

We will not tolerate any of these behaviors:

- Profanity
- Unsafe behavior
- Lewd or lascivious behavior
- Bullying or Hazing
- Harassment
- Physical violence
- Defiance or disregard of supervising adults

Infractions of stated behaviors and/or program guidelines and requirements will result in the following consequences:
