

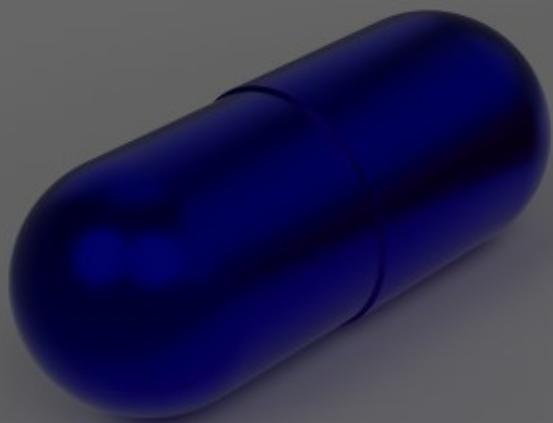

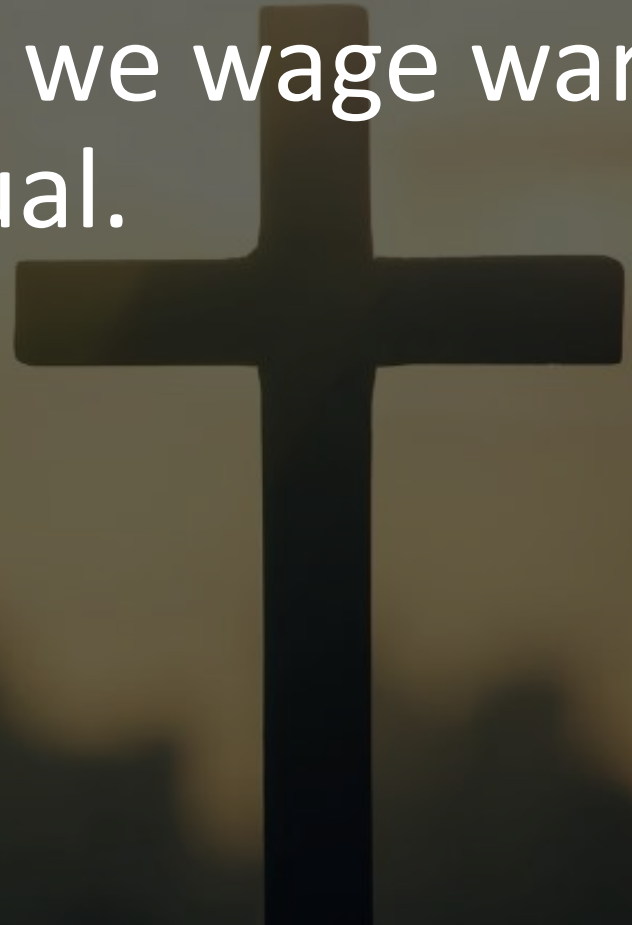

is spiritual.



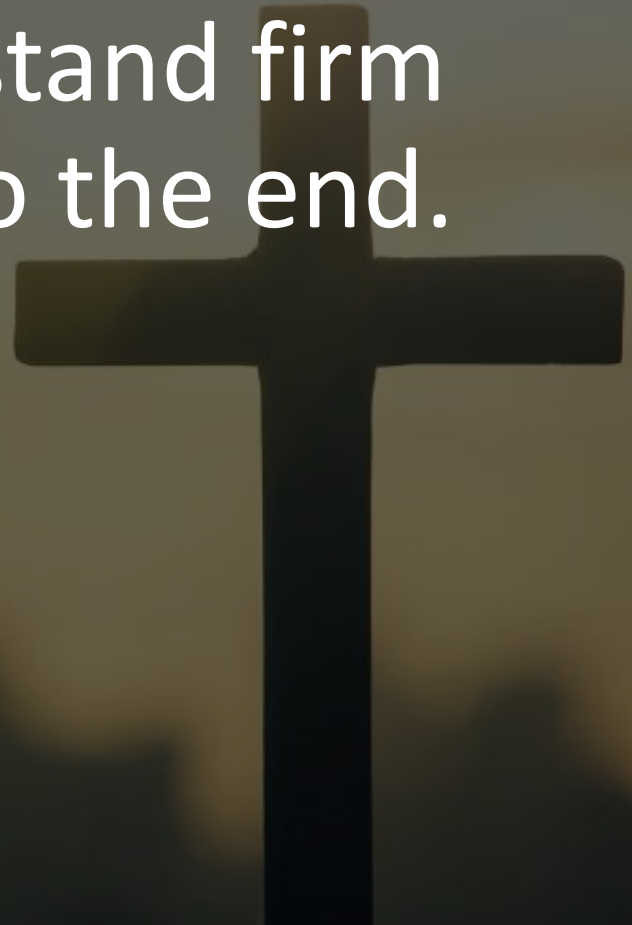


Thus, we need armament and weapons designed for this spiritual war if we are to stand victorious.
