- Strategize and participate in a church planting vision for our church.
- Develop and manage a financial plan and budget for the fiscal year.
- Participate as an Elder in guiding the overall vision and direction of the church.
- Preach occasionally in coordination with the Lead Pastor and Elders.
- Attend and participate in staff meetings, church functions and ministry events to build and foster community.
- Regularly attend and encourage the team to attend conferences and events to develop spiritual life, spiritual gifts, and leadership skills in the areas of Next Gen.
