Animal Shelter Monthly Report

Melissa Goff the Director of the Christian County Animal Shelter gave her monthly report for May 2025.

Christian County Emergency Management Director, Randy Graham shared updates on the current FEMA process relating to Christian County’s recent flood and tornado damages. Currently about 404 have registered for assistance and over 3 million dollars has been issued by FEMA for repairs. The FEMA application process has been extended to July 24th, 2025, and if individuals need assistance with registration, they can call 270-887-6253.

Esquire Guffey thanked all the volunteers and the Christian County Road Department employees for their clean-up efforts after of the recent flood and tornado damages our county has experienced in recent months.

Esquire Barnett mentioned a rate increase from the Christian County Water District and the rate increase should be finalized in the next few months.

Esquire Ferguson thanked all those involved in the Chamber of Commerce 136th Annual Dinner.
