RESOLUTION 2025-20**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CHRISTIAN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
AUTHORIZING THE CHRISTIAN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT
TO ENCROACH UPON CERTAIN COUNTY-MAINTAINED
RIGHTS-OF-WAY FOR THE PHASE IX WATER SYSTEM
UPGRADES PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY
JUDGE EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS
IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.**

WHEREAS, the Christian County Water District has undertaken the Phase IX Water System Upgrades Project to upgrade and replace over 4 miles of waterline to serve the citizens of Christian County; and

WHEREAS, this project includes the replacement of pump stations and suction lines for the Dawson Springs Road Pump Station and Madisonville Road Pump Station sites; and

WHEREAS, the work will replace two pump stations with one new station plus new waterlines serving large portions of the Antioch Church Road corridor; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish this project, the District needs to bore under or cross approximately 145 feet certain County-maintained roads including Old Buttermilk Road, Zander Road, Cumbee Road, and Rogers Road, thereby encroaching into the County-maintained right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Christian County Fiscal Court recognizes the necessity of these water system improvements for the betterment of the County and its residents;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Christian Fiscal Court as follows:

1. The Christian County Fiscal Court hereby authorizes the Christian County Water District to encroach upon the County-maintained rights-of-way on portions of Old Buttermilk Road, Zander Road, Cumbee Road, and Rogers Road for purposes of the Phase IX Water System Upgrades Project.
2. The Christian County Judge Executive is hereby authorized to execute an encroachment permit, road warranty agreement, and any other necessary documents to effectuate the encroachment authorized herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization is granted subject to the Christian County Water District complying with all applicable regulations and restoring any affected roadways to their original or better condition upon completion of the work.

Adopted at a regular meeting of Christian Fiscal Court held on December 23rd, 2025, a quorum present and voting.
