**Sunday 3rd December** will be the First Sunday of Advent. Not only will we enter a solemn and sacred season, but we will begin a new liturgical year. If you use a missal to follow the readings, we will be in Year B (which means we will be hearing from the Gospel of St Mark on Sundays throughout the year) and on Weekdays it will be readings for Year II. It's important that we begin this time together, as a parish, in prayer. So, we will celebrate the official Evening Prayer of the Church (called Vespers) on Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> December at 5pm, followed by (non-alcoholic!) mulled wine and mince pies.


