

## Sacred Heart Parish, Bordon

Today we begin the First Week of Lent – 40 days and 40 nights, lasting until Maundy Thursday.

Lent is more than a 'box-ticking exercise' it is a change of attitude, way of living, or a change of our 'mindset'.

We heard the Lord say on Ash Wednesday (in the First Reading):

'come back to me with all your hearts, fasting, weeping mourning. Let your hearts be broken, not your garments torn'.

Lent is a time for **interior change**, a change of heart – more than just outward signs or observances. The real value of the Lenten Resolutions we have made will be

realised in our spiritual growth and maturity this Lent.

The three areas we concentrate on in Lent of Prayer (listening to God), Fasting (denying the self) and almsgiving (serving the other) will only become more than 'parading our good deeds before men' as Jesus warned in the Gospel on Ash Wednesday if those three areas change us spiritually – changing our heart.

Please do come along on Sunday evening at 6pm so that we can pray Evening Prayer together (vespers) entering into this sacred and solemn season of self-denial lasting the next 40 days & nights.....

#### First Sunday of Lent Evening Prayer


Please came along to Vespers (Evening Prayer) on Sunday at 6pm.

## Lent is different .....

## On Ash Wednesday we will hear in the First Reading:

"Sound the trumpet in Zion! Order a fast, proclaim a solemn assembly, call the people together, summon the community, assemble the elders, gather the children, even the infants at the breast.

Let the bridegroom leave his bedroom and the bride her alcove.

Between vestibule and altar let the priests, the ministers of the Lord, lament. Let them say: 'Spare your people, Lord".

And this sets the scene for the next 40 days and 40 nights of Lent..... So, during Lent the priests pause between the vestibule and the altar and lament 'Kyrie eleison!' Lord have mercy. Instead of standing, we all kneel and examine our conscience and we call upon the mercy of God.

There will be no 'Gloria' no 'alleluia'; no flowers in the church and the liturgical colour is violet reminding us that Lent is a time of penance, sacrifice and self-denial.

We pray and fast in the weeks of Lent and the usual parish activities will take place to support you in all your efforts and to offer ideas for things you might do during Lent:

Mon: 10am Mass followed by Bible studies.

**Tues:** Confessions at 6pm followed by Stations of the Cross at 6:15pm and then Holy Mass at 7pm. Adult formation will take place after Mass until 8:30pm.

Wed: early morning Mass at 0730am.

**Fri:** Adoration and Confessions at 11am, Stations at 11:15am and Holy Mass at Midday followed by a Lenten soup lunch.

**Sat:** Adoration and Confessions at 5pm followed by Holy Mass at 6pm.

On Ash Wednesday we began our 'campaign of Christian Service'. We received the Ashes as a sign of penance and we began to work on three areas of our life that Jesus highlighted in the Gospel: **Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving.** We keep these resolutions until the end of the Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday.

The liturgical countdown of the 40 days and 40 nights, (imitating Jesus's time in the desert), doesn't begin until the 'First Sunday in Lent' which begins the 'First Week of Lent'. If we follow Mass in our missals, we will see that we have:

Ash Wednesday, Thursday after Ash Wednesday, Friday after Ash Wednesday, Saturday after Ash Wednesday and then, the First Sunday of Lent. (These days are marked in purple above). Then we begin 'the First week of Lent.

After the countdown, we have the Sacred Triduum, marked in red above. If we include the 3 purple days and the 3 red days, we will have 46 days and 46 nights!

During the 40 days of the Season of Lent we prepare ourselves for the Sacred Triduum which is one Liturgy celebrated across three days - Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday make one Liturgy. We begin with the sign of the Cross on Maundy Thursday and there is no final blessing until Holy Saturday.

If we prepare well for those three days, if we live a good and holy Lent, the Lord will draw us into a deeper relationship with Himself. He will deepen our faith and increase our trust in Him.

There are many things on offer to you in the Parish this Lent, to help and support you in your efforts. Please do come along and not only receive support but, by your very presence, offer support to other members of the parish too.


