

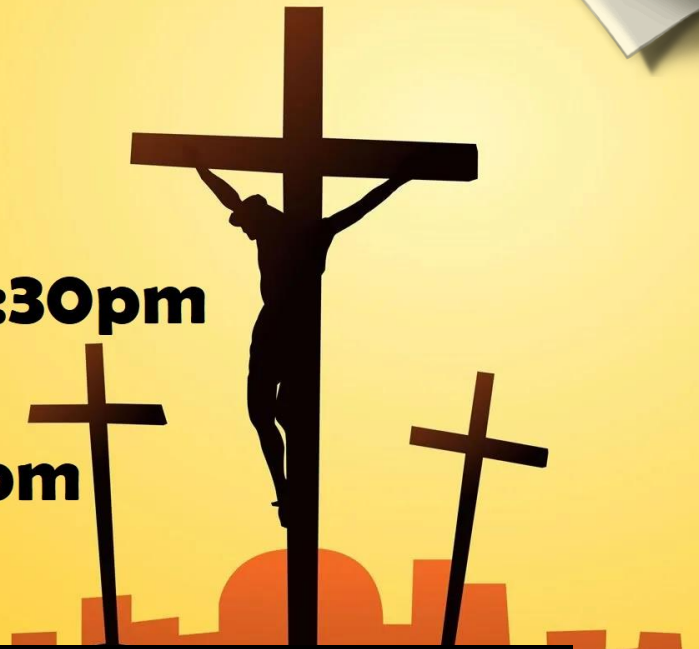

We begin today the most important week of the year for all Catholics. The week ahead will present to us, afresh, the essence of our faith.

We will revisit, together, the Paschal Mysteries, that is to say the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord.

We have spent the past five weeks preparing the Body, Soul and Spirit for the week ahead. We've been strengthening our self-control and developing weapons of self-restraint.

When we think of the feeding of the 5,000, we remember that they all had as much as they wanted and there were 12 baskets full of waste – they didn't want everything that was being offered to them, they missed so much, they wasted a lot.

We face the same situation this week. The Lord wants to offer us more than we can imagine, but we will only receive as much as we want, the rest we will waste.

We have worked hard this Lent. Let's make sure we are ready to receive every grace and blessing the Lord is waiting to pour out upon us this Holy Week.


