Plenary Indulgence

When we die, we enter into eternity – there is no time. So, when we stand before God everything we did or failed to do, good or bad will be recalled in an instant. That moment is called our Personal Judgement.

God, in His mercy allows for other people to carry out good works on our behalf, meaning that the credit / grace / reward they would have received can be applied to us in our Judgement.

In that moment of judgment, outside of time, all those good works carried out on our behalf will be applied to us too. Even if an act was carried out 50 years after our death – in time – it will be applied to us outside of time.

During the month of November we can carry out all kinds of works of mercy to be applied to our deceased loved ones, even if they died 100 years ago!


The Church offers a **Plenary Indulgence** for a Cemetery Visit from 1st November through to 8th November. It is applicable only to the souls in Purgatory. As a plenary indulgence, it remits all punishment due to sin, which means that simply by performing the requirements of the indulgence, you can obtain the entrance into Heaven of a soul who is currently suffering in Purgatory.

To obtain this Plenary Indulgence, we must receive Holy Communion and sacramental Confession.

Holy Communion must be received each day we wish to gain the indulgence, but we only need to go to Confession once during the period. A good prayer to recite to earn the indulgence is the Eternal Rest, though any formal or informal prayer for the dead will suffice. And, as with all plenary indulgences, we must pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (one Our Father and one Hail Mary) each day we perform the work of the indulgence.
