

The goal of prayer is to listen and to learn.

We are supposed to listen and learn from God by the way! Some think that God should listen and learn from us!!

In fact, that's the most common mistake made when it comes to prayer. So many people think prayer is informing God about world events and tragedies (as if He didn't already know) and then tell Him how to fix things and sort out the problems. They often give God a deadline too to make sure He does as He is told before a convenient date and time.

That is not prayer.

Prayer is when we listen to God, as Mary does in the Gospel today.

Prayer is when we free ourselves form the distractions of Martha and sit at the feet of God, listening and learning from Him.

Our mantra is 'speak Lord for your servant is listening'.... Not 'listen Lord for your servant is speaking'.

God is not our servant. We are not His equal. When we learn these things, we will begin to pray properly.
