Our plans to connect the Church grounds with the Town Park and the Shed have moved forward significantly in recent weeks.

A gate and new walkway will be built roughly where the yellow lines are in the photo above - at no cost to us.

The path will be beautifully landscaped and will provide access for people to take a shortcut from the Shed to the High Street. This will mean that the footfall passing the church door will be increased, and we will also be able to host larger-scale events, working with the Shed and the local Council.

Prior to the path being built we'd like to make some alterations to the carpark too. We'd like to extend the grassed area as far as the red line above, increasing space for our parish social events and other activities.

This will mean (a) lifting the bricks to the right of the red line (b) moving the curb and (c) removing the bushes within that space.

We will use those bricks to patch another hole that will be made during the reconfiguration.....



We plan to remove the bushes circled in blue, and replace the lifted bricks here, meaning that we will lose no parking spaces by these changes.

Family learning from the Catechism:

The Lord praised prudence in the Gospel last weekend. Prudence is one of the Theological Virtues. The Cardinal Virtues are Prudence, Justice, Fortitude and temperance. We looked at Prudence last week so here is Justice this week:

1807 Justice is the moral virtue that consists in the constant and firm will to give their due to God and neighbour. Justice toward God is called the "virtue of religion." Justice toward men disposes one to respect the rights of each and to establish in human relationships the harmony that promotes equity with regard to persons and to the common good. the just man, often mentioned in the Sacred Scriptures, is distinguished by habitual right thinking and the uprightness of his conduct toward his neighbour. "You shall not be partial to the poor or defer to the great, but in righteousness shall you judge your neighbour." "Masters, treat your slaves justly and fairly, knowing that you also have a Master in heaven."
