





For the next few weeks, the Lord will be inviting us to take a closer look at our 'interior life'.

We'll be asked to identify certain **attitudes** that we have, especially those attitudes which prevent us from growing in holiness and closer to God.

Last weekend we were given the man who assumed that the seat of honour was for him and then, to his shame, was asked to move lower.

That sense of 'entitlement' is incompatible with discipleship as we will hear this weekend.

Jesus says in this week's Gospel: "Whoever does not bear his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple".

Entitlement tells us that we do not deserve any kind of cross in our life. Entitlement sees suffering or discomfort as belonging to someone else and never mine.

We cannot be a disciple without the cross Jesus says and so entitlement really is incompatible with discipleship.

From the Catechism: Entitlement

Feeling entitled is rooted in the capital sin, 'Pride'. We learn humility in prayer, acknowledging that we depend on God for everything:

2559 "Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God." But when we pray, do we speak from the height of our pride and will, or "out of the depths" of a humble and contrite heart? He who humbles himself will be exalted; humility is the foundation of prayer, Only when we humbly acknowledge that "we do not know how to pray as we ought," are we ready to receive freely the gift of prayer. "Man is a beggar before God."

<u>2540</u> Envy represents a form of sadness and therefore a refusal of charity; the baptized person should struggle against it by exercising good will. Envy often comes from pride; the baptized person should train himself to live in humility.
