

† CONFESSION OF FAITH

The Apostle's Creed

Leader: Let us declare together what we believe as a church:

Although not written by the apostles, the Apostles' Creed is a concise summary of their teachings. It originated as a baptismal confession in the 2nd century and developed into its present form in the 6th or 7th century.

All: I believe in God, the Father almighty,
creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit
and born of the virgin Mary.
He suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died, and was buried;
he descended to hell.
The third day he rose again from the dead.
He ascended to heaven
and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty.
From there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the holy catholic* church,
the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body,
and the life everlasting. Amen.

*catholic = *universal*

GOD CLEANSES US

Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

CONFESSON OF SIN

Based on 1 John 1:6-7

Leader: Let us now confess that we have sinned against God:

All: Father, thank you for the fellowship we have with you through your Son, who took on flesh and died in our place. We confess that though we say we have fellowship with You, we practice the unloving deeds of darkness, and do not practice the truth. Help us to walk in the light, as he is in the light. Help us to maintain the unity with Christ and one another by walking in love. We confess our sins; please forgive us. In Christ's name, Amen.

SILENT CONFESSON OF PERSONAL SIN

The scripture that follows our confession assures us of God's forgiveness, grace and pardon. This is the good news.

PROMISE OF PARDONING GRACE

1 John 4:10

Leader: In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.
