† CONFESSION OF FAITH

Westminster Shorter Catechism Q. 73, 74, 75

Leader: Let us confess the laws by which Jesus rules His Kingdom. What is the eighth commandment?

All: The eighth commandment is, "You shall not steal."

Leader: What is required in the eighth commandment?

All: The eighth commandment requires lawfully procuring and furthering the wealth and outward state of ourselves and others.

Leader: What is forbidden in the eighth commandment?

All: The eighth commandment forbids anything that may unjustly hinder our own or our neighbor's wealth or outward state.

CONFESSION OF SIN

Leader: Let us confess our sin the God over everything:

All: Father in heaven, you have provided everything necessary for life and godliness, yet we want more. We confess that we have stolen from your glory and from our neighbors. We have stolen from our neighbors' name, good, and future, with our words and actions. We confess to breaking your commandment, and we ask for your forgiveness. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.
