Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

† **CONFESSION OF FAITH**

Westminster Shorter Catechism Q. 79, 80, 81

Leader: Let us confess the laws of Kingdom of God. What is the tenth commandment?

All: The tenth commandment is, “You shall not covet your neighbor’s house; you shall not covet your neighbor’s wife, or his male servant, or his female servant, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything that is your neighbor’s.”

Leader: What is required in the tenth commandment?

All: The tenth commandment requires full contentment with our own condition, with a correct and charitable orientation of our spirit toward our neighbors and all that is theirs.

Leader: What is forbidden in the tenth commandment?

All: The tenth commandment forbids all manner of discontentment with our own state, envying or grieving at the good state of our neighbors, and all excessive feelings and desires for anything that belongs to them.

CONFESSION OF SIN

Leader: Let us confess our sin to our Father in heaven.

All: Father, we acknowledge our wickedness to you. From your grace, you give us good things, but from our sin, we have not trusted you, been thankful, or shown contentment. We have broken all the commandments due to our distrust and coveting. We come before You, confessing our sins and our failure to delight in Your perfect provision. Please forgive us according to the greatest provision of love, Your Son, Jesus, in His name we pray, Amen.
