The scripture that follows our confession assures us of God's forgiveness, grace and pardon. This is the good news.

CONFESSION OF SIN

Confess using Jer 2:19-21

Leader: Let us now, as a people chosen by God, redeemed by Christ, and sealed by the Spirit, confess our sins together:

All: We believe in one God, Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible, and yet we have forsaken you and do not fear you. Long ago, you broke our yokes and bonds, but we said, "I will not serve you". You planted us as a choice vine, a pure seed, but we have turned into a wild vine. We confess to our sin and ask you to remember us and forgive us. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.
