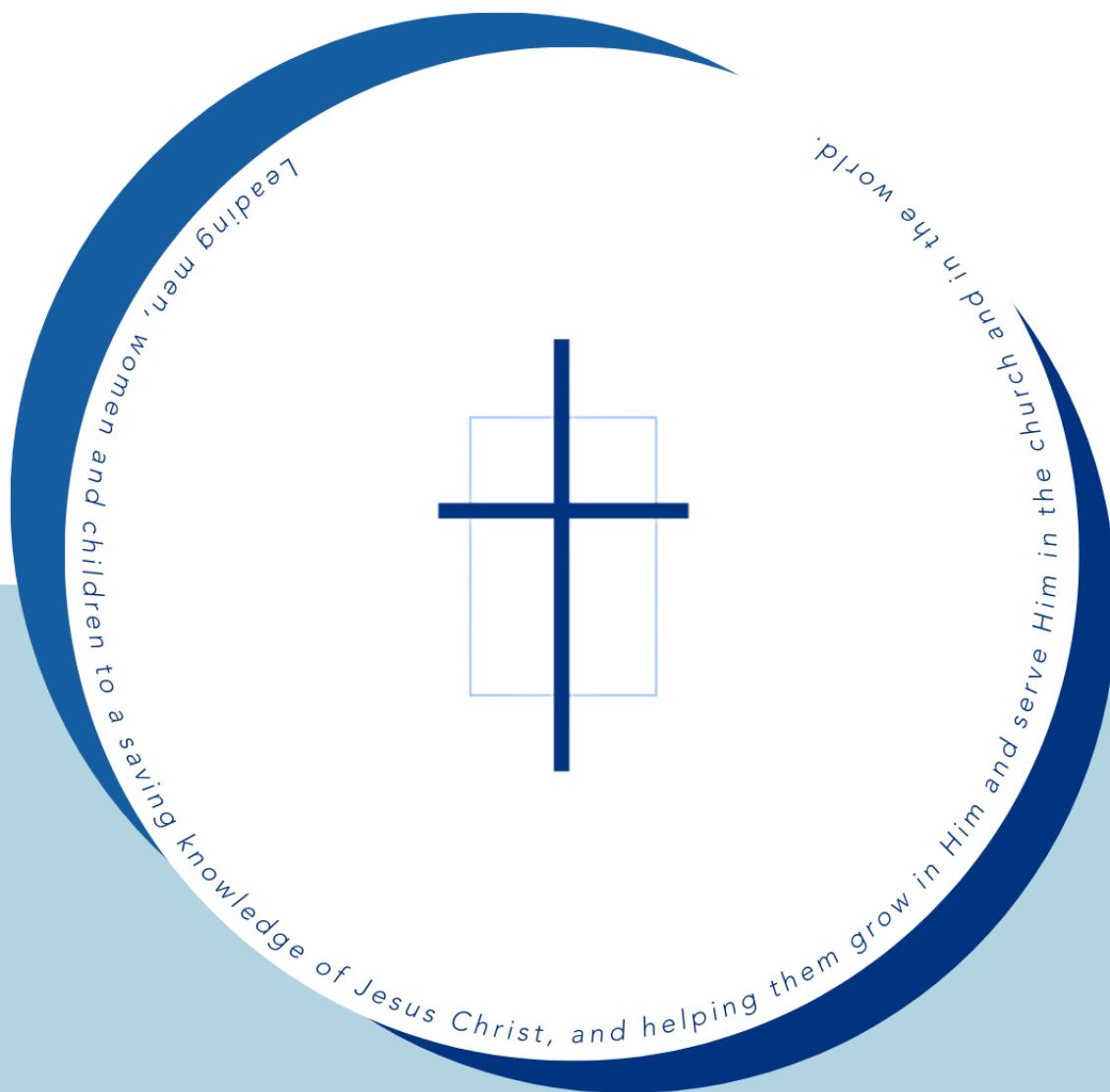

## † CONFESSION OF FAITH

Westminster Larger Catechism, 103 & 104

**Leader:** Let us confess together what we believe: Which is the first commandment?

**All:** The first commandment is, Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

**Leader:** What are the duties required in the first commandment?

**All:** The duties required in the first commandment are, the knowing and acknowledging of God to be the only true God, and our God; and to worship and glorify him accordingly, by thinking, meditating, remembering, highly esteeming, honoring, adoring, choosing, loving, desiring, fearing of him; believing him; trusting, hoping, delighting, rejoicing in him; being zealous for him; calling upon him; giving all praise and thanks, and yielding all obedience and submission to him with the whole man; being careful in all things to please him, and sorrowful when in anything he is offended; and walking humbly with him.

## CONFESSIOIN OF SIN

**Leader:** In light of God's glory and greatness, and our apathy and disobedience, let us confess our sins together before Him now:

**All:** Almighty and most merciful Father, we rejoice in your mercy; it is higher than the heavens, deeper than the sea, wider than our wanderings, greater than all our sin. Forgive our careless attitude toward your sovereign design for us, our complaining when in trial, our envy of the perceived well-being of others, our obsession with pleasing ourselves, our indifference to the needs of others, our neglect of your commands. Help us to repent of these transgressions and seek you with all our heart, so we might walk in your ways, until you call us home. In Christ's name. Amen.<sup>2</sup>

We are a Confessional Church. We choose to stand shoulder to shoulder with those saints who have gone before us. We embrace the timeless doctrinal truths of the Gospel.

## GOD CLEANSES US

Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

The scripture that follows our confession assures us of God's forgiveness, grace and pardon. This is the good news.

Our giving is an act of worship; it is both a response of gratitude for God's generosity toward us and a sign of faith in God's future provision.

#### GOD COMMUNICATES WITH US

God's Word itself has power. The Preaching of God's Word is one of the chief means of grace by which God's people grow.

#### GOD COMMISSIONS US

Our worship concludes with God's sending us into the world with his blessing as we seek to love our community.
