

#### † CALL TO WORSHIP

Psalm 92:1-4

All: It is good to give thanks to the LORD, to sing praises to your name, O Most High; to declare your steadfast love in the morning, and your faithfulness by night, to the music of the lute and the harp, to the melody of the lyre. For you, O LORD, have made me glad by your work; at the works of your hands I sing for joy.

**† CONFESSION OF FAITH** Westminster Confession of Faith, Ch. V, Sec. 1

**Leader**: Let us declare together what we believe the Scriptures teach: What do you believe about the Providence of God?

**All**: God, the great Creator of all things doth uphold, direct, dispose, and govern all creatures, actions, and things, from the greatest even to the least, by His most wise and holy providence, according to His infallible fore-knowledge, and the free and immutable counsel of His own will, to the praise of the glory of His wisdom, power, justice, goodness, and mercy.

#### GOD CLEANSES US

Within the context of our relationship with God, we are invited in safety, not shame, to consider our sins. God loves us in spite of our sins. We rehearse this truth each week by confessing our sins corporately and leaning into his renewal, restoration, and cleansing.

The scripture that follows our confession assures us of God's forgiveness, grace and pardon. This is the good news.

Our giving is an act of worship; it is both a response of gratitude for God's generosity toward us and a sign of faith in God's future provision.

#### **CONFESSION OF SIN**

Based on Gal. 5:14 & WSC No. 14

Leader: Let us now confess our sins together before our God:

**All**: Sin is any want of conformity unto or transgression of the Law of God. There are a multitude of ways in which we have fallen short of your Law. Principally we have failed to love you with all our heart, mind, and soul, and we have equally failed to love our neighbor as ourselves. And your Word reminds us that 'the works of the flesh' consist of unclean thoughts, a spirit of enmity, endlessly causing strife, jealousy, fits of anger, envy, and much more. Come, Holy Spirit, and complete what you have begun and make us more like Jesus every day. In Jesus' name. Amen.<sup>1</sup>

#### PROMISE OF PARDONING GRACE

Psalm 103:8-12

Leader: The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. He will not always chide, nor will he keep his anger forever.
