Verses for the week: John 20:24-31

Questions:

1. Verse 25 says Thomas refused to believe Jesus was alive unless he actually “placed his finger in the mark of the nails, and placed his hand into his side.” Do people today still approach Jesus this way? If so, why?

2. What did Jesus mean in Verse 29 when he said to Thomas, “Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed?”

How does this relate to “faith”?

Side note: Wouldn't it be great to know the “many other signs” Jesus did “in the presence of the disciples?” (See Verse 31.)
