Joshua – Small Group Study Week Seven

Verses for the week: Joshua 7

Questions:

1. In <u>Verse 1</u>, the Bible says Achan sinned by taking some of the "devoted <u>things</u>", which also could be a metaphor for "<u>things</u> of this world," "<u>things</u> that take you away from God," or "<u>things</u> that create pride and sin." What happens in <u>Verses 2-5</u> to the people of Israel because of this sin?

What was Joshua's response in Verses 6-9?

What was God's response in Verses 10-15?

2. What can we learn from this <u>Chapter</u> (i) about sin and "devoted <u>things</u>", (ii) about how we should respond to sin and "devoted <u>things</u>", and (iii) about the character of God?
